

The Honorary Consulate of the Republic of Poland in Florida was established in October 1998. For two decades, Honorary Consul Lady Blanka Rosenstiel and Honorary Vice Consul Beata Paszyc have provided information and perform consular services free of charge.

Although the Honorary Consulate cannot by law issue, sign or verify any documents, it does provide general information and serves as a helping hand to the Consulate General in Washington, DC. The recent changes in the law require that all passport applications **MUST** be submitted in person to the Consulate General in the appropriate territorial jurisdiction. Therefore, the Consulate General in Washington, D.C. organizes visits to various locations, including Miami, FL, to enable Polish citizens to personally submit passport applications closer to their residence.
